Cardboard Boat Race Rules

Construction

All Boats must be built of corrugated cardboard and if the judge deem it necessary, must pass the dreaded "Ice Pick Test" and Metal detector test! This verifies that the boat is constructed of only cardboard. No Motors. Your cardboard boat may be as thick as you want it to be. Thickness of cardboard doesn't matter at all. Remember, it must be all cardboard - NOT cardboard and wood or cardboard and metal or metal screws for holding. The entire boat must be built of corrugated cardboard. The only exceptions are oars, propulsion system and steering devices. These exceptions are of course, not part of the boat proper and can be constructed of materials other than cardboard. If you don't want your boat to sink, the committee urges you to waterproof the entire boat with a one-part

substance paint. (A two-part substance would include those that require the addition of a catalyst or hardener.... This eliminates epoxy glue, fiberglass, and certain varnishes. One-part waterproofing substances are easily obtained at a paint or hardware store.)

You cannot wrap the entire boat with plastic or duct tape or any similar tape or wrap. Duck tape can only be used on the seams and stress points. However you are allowed to reinforce all seams and stress points with tape before waterproofing.

Contestants are not allowed to use any substance which might be harmful to the environment. Contestants should take care to ensure that the construction of your boat does not include pointed projections and sharp edges that might cause personal injury.
